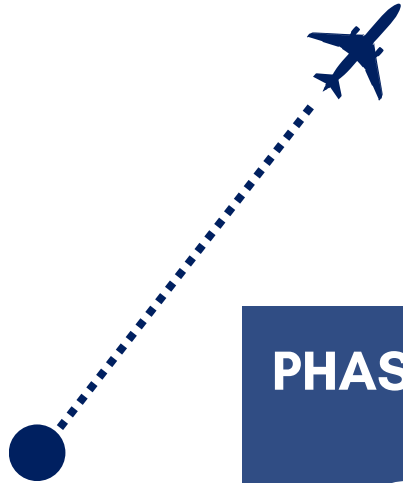

FAQs

Entry Requirements

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Complete the ADAPT test
- Hold NCEA Level 3 (with 14 credits in English rich and Maths rich subjects)
- Hold an NZ CAA Class 1 medical certificate
- Meet the 'Fit & Proper Person' requirements of NZ CAA

Application Process

- Submit the application form along with the required documents
- If your application is accepted, you will be advised to complete the online test "ADAPT"

Selection Process

Stage 1: Interview (Zoom)
Stage 2: Entry Assessment (on-site)
Stage 3: If successful you will be issued with an offer letter

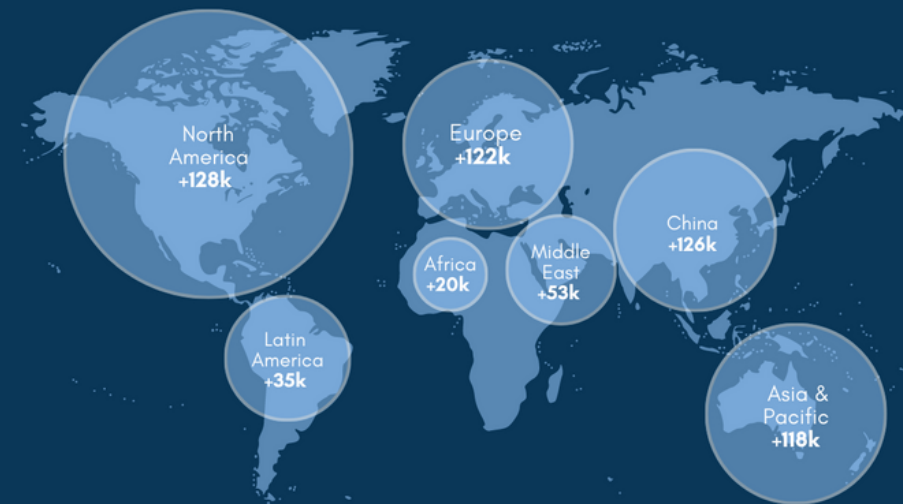
